PRAYER: It is the most important thing we can do in preparation for this service/event. Let's not only pray that people will come out and support it, but that they will come with an open heart and open mind to receive whatever God has for them. Let's agree together in prayer that lives will be changed and souls will be saved during this appointed time of fellowship.

WORD OF MOUTH: As in any case the most effective form of advertisement is word of mouth. Be sure to start announcing your scheduled service/event with RESTORATION immediately; make an effort to announce it often. Tell people to write the date on their calendars and ask everyone to help you spread the word by inviting family, friends and co-workers. Call local Pastors to invite them and ask if they would announce the event for you as well, it is always great to fellowship with other congregations.

WEBSITE: If you have a home on the web make sure to post the information for this service/event on your site. Display this information in a highly visible location so that any visitors to your site will be informed of the event.

CHURCH BULLETINS: No later than one month prior to the scheduled date; start featuring this event in your church bulletin or newsletter.

CHURCH SIGN/MARQUEE: Post the event information on your church sign or marquee approximately 2 weeks prior to the scheduled date.

POSTERS: Place posters in various locations throughout your community to make the public aware of the service/event. On the posters, be sure to include date, time and place, as well as a phone number they could call for more information about the event. Some great places to consider putting posters would be local grocery stores, gas stations, hair salons, bookstores, music stores, church bulletin boards, or any type of family oriented business in your area. Remember, it is always respectful to ask permission at each location prior to hanging a poster. Should you require additional posters you can print them directly from the media page on our website, if you prefer printed copies please feel free to contact us and we would be happy to accommodate your needs.

NEWSPAPERS: Most local newspapers have a Community Events Calendar where you can advertise your event for free. Most newspapers require advance notice to post events, so check with your local paper for their specific deadlines

RADIO: If you have a local Southern Gospel radio station, they will often announce local events for you at no charge. Some stations will also post information for community events on their website.

Use every resource and opportunity available to invite and encourage people within your community to come out and be a part. If you are excited about this event, it will show! Be optimistic, the people around you will become enthused by your excitement and may be motivated to join us for this time of worship.
